SMALL GROUP SERMON DISCUSSION

- 1. Describe a time when you built up something in your mind to be difficult that turned out to be easy!
- 2. Read Proverbs 4:23. Discuss what this verse tells us about the importance of our thoughts and what they control.
- 3. Read Romans 12:2. What does this verse say about how we come to know the will of God? What does it say about the effects of God's word on your mind?
- 4. Anytime we sin, at that moment we're believing a lie. According to Proverbs 14:12 and James 1:14-15, what is all too often the typical progression of events leading to death when we're believing a lie? How can we escape?
- 5. Read 1 Peter 4:1 and discuss why Jesus is able to understand what we are going through, and why he is the best model for our thoughts. Discuss what you do each day to learn to think like Jesus. Talk about this process with your group.
- 6. Rethinking our lives to match how Jesus thinks is called repenting, which comes from the Greek word Metanoia meaning "to change your mind." Read Acts 3:19 and talk about what the verse says are some of the results of repentance. Discuss where you plan to "change your mind" (or repent) to line up with how Jesus thinks.
- 7. Discuss how Romans 8:6 and 2 Corinthians 10:3-5 teach us how to win the battle in & for our minds by having God's Spirit & God's word inside us. How will you increase the influence of the Spirit and word in you?
